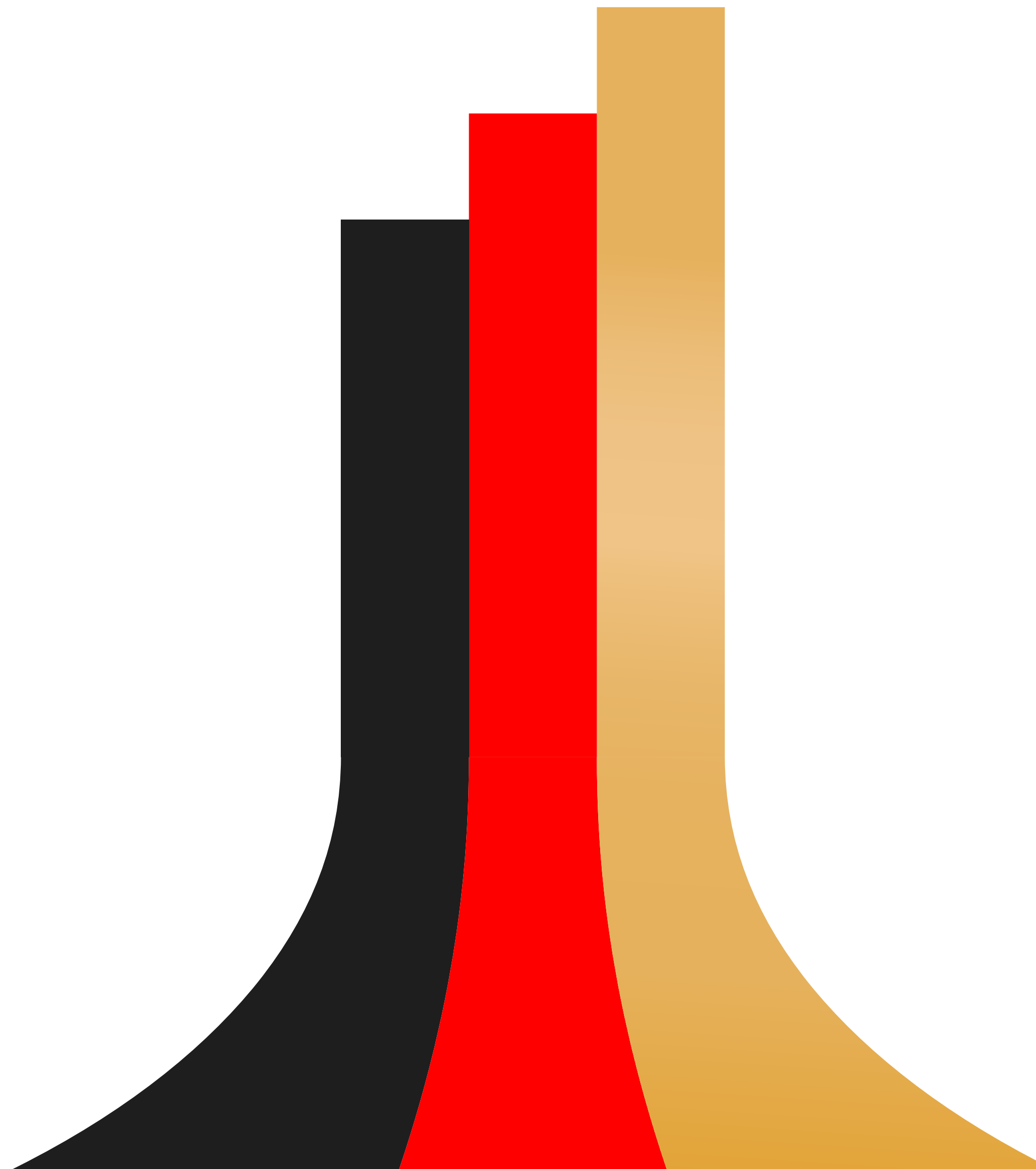

The Summit in Berlin

A key event this year is the international *Invest in Germany* Summit in Berlin on 19 & 20 October. This event marks the inaugural Summit hosted by the Federal Government, introducing a new high-level platform for international investors.

High-Level Networking

The Summit convenes a curated network of international and domestic corporate leaders alongside major institutional investors, and Germany's top government representatives to turn potential into projects.

A Dialogue-Oriented Initiative

A key focus will be on confidential, high-level dialogue between our leading politicians and global investors. Equally, the Summit provides an extensive forum for peer-to-peer exchange,

allowing business leaders to align perspectives and explore collaborative opportunities.
